One of the main priorities for development of Georgia is advancement of tourism and related to it fields, that sets certain requirements to education system and namely to higher education system. Ministry of Education of Georgia has made several steps to meet this challenge, including legislative changes as well as specific activities. The most noteworthy are enhancement of studies of foreign, namely English language and making compulsory for students having certificate of English language for graduating from higher education institutions.
